Tuition fees include curriculum, (P-6) classroom stationery, textbooks, College diaries, sports carnivals and transport, swimming pool entry and student accident insurance. Tuition fees do not cover the cost of uniforms, student laptops or daily bus fees from and to home.

Tuition fees are discounted by 25% if a parent can produce satisfactory documentary evidence to support the application for a pastoral discount. The eligibility for a pastoral discount is determined by Coolum Christian Family Church.

Campus Development Levy – Non-Tax Deductible

A compulsory levy per family which contributes to new buildings, improving existing facilities and major refurbishments.

Parents and Friends Levy

PAYMENT OPTIONS And discount

Tuition fees, Outdoor Education, Family Levies and Bus Fees where applicable, for all four terms will be invoiced at the start of the year.

Note: The policy of the College is to enter into a direct debit arrangement with the family as part of the enrolment process.

Option 3	Full Year Payment in advance by 22 January 2021. 5% Discount on annual tuition fees.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

No family should endure unreasonable financial hardship because of tuition fees. A limited amount of concessional financial assistance is available for families in genuine need on a short-term basis. Please contact the Business Office for more information.

Notice of withdrawal

If families are intending to leave the College, a written withdrawal notice must be sent to the College as soon as possible. Written notice is to be supplied a FULL TERM, excluding school holidays, prior to the last day of the student/s attendance, otherwise **one Term's** fees will be charged for insufficient notice.

Bus Service

The College bus service, which is available to all families, is efficient and affordable.

Our buses service three main areas:

- **Inner Coolum** – encompasses Emu Mountain Rd to Tanah Street, i.e. Coolum Beach; Point Arkwright; Yaroomba; Mt Coolum from Stumers Creek.
- **Outer Coolum** - encompasses South from Heron Street Peregian to Emu Mountain Rd, and South from Tanah street to the Northern Boundary of the Airport, West to Valdora RD i.e. Peregian Springs, Yandina Creek, Valdora, Maroochy River - North of the river, Tanah Street Mt Coolum to Petrie Ave Marcoola.
- **Other Routes** – encompasses North from Heron street Peregian to South from the Northern boundary of the airport and West from Valdora Rd, i.e. Peregian Beach; Noosa; Yandina; Maroochy River (South of the river); Bli-Bli; Marcoola; Maroochydore and Nambour.
