1. **Representative School Sport Financial Arrangements Policy:**
 - This policy outlines the financial arrangements for **representative school sport programs** in Queensland. It is designed to support the objectives set by the **Queensland School Sport Unit** and the **Regional School Sport Offices**.
 - Key principles include:
 - **Minimizing player participation fees:** Efforts are made to keep costs low and transparent.
 - **Allowable costs:** Only specific costs related to participation can be included in player fees (e.g., travel, uniforms).
 - **Financial transparency:** Arrangements must be open and clear.
 - [If a student faces financial hardship, the respective school sport body will consider their specific circumstances¹.](#)
2. **Emerging Athlete Pathways Program:**
 - This program provides financial assistance to eligible young athletes, coaches, and officials aged 10-18 years. It helps cover costs associated with attending state, national, and international events.
 - [High-performing student-athletes can explore various subsidies and assistance options through this program².](#)
3. **Club Support and Funding:**
 - For students involved in clubs, there are funding opportunities available. These include:
 - **Financial support for young athletes:** Helping them participate in sports.
 - **Club upgrades:** Funds to enhance facilities and increase membership.
